Think with Mira

Every table at Xin comes with food for your body — and a thinking partner for the idea you've been carrying around.

WHO IS MIRA?

Mira is Xin's ideation coach — named after a real woman, our founder's mother, who taught her daughter to think, to do, and to innovate. Bring her a business dream, a school project, a neighbourhood problem, an invention, or just a feeling that *something could be better*. She'll help you build it — over dinner.

HOW TO START (30 SECONDS)

- 1 Look at the board** (or your bill) for today's house code — something tasty like **MOMO-42**. Or just scan the QR on your table.
- 2 Tap "Think with Mira"** on xin.community, enter the code, and tell her your name and number — so she remembers you next visit.
- 3 Say what's on your mind.** A half-formed thought is a perfect start. She'll take it from there.

Build your idea with you

She contributes ideas, challenges weak spots kindly, and helps you choose a direction.



Sketch it

Say "sketch it for me" — she draws layouts, storyboards and diagrams right in the chat.



Read your napkin

Photograph your scribbles and drawings — she reads them and builds on them.



Paint the vision

Once per meal, ask for a concept visual — a full illustration of your idea.



Think through your files

Hand her a PDF, Excel or CSV with the  — budgets, plans, menus, anything.



Land it as a Spark Card

Finish with a beautiful card of your idea, with your name on it — save it, share it, post it on the Canvas.

THE HOUSE RULES

- **Your dining session** lasts up to 40 messages or 60 minutes — plenty for a great idea and a great meal.
- **Nothing is lost.** Your conversations are kept — continue any of them at xin.community/mira, from home, anytime, free.
- **25 votes wins the wall.** Post your idea on the Canvas; if the community loves it, dinner's on us.
- **She's a thinking partner**, not a homework machine — she'll warmly steer you back to the idea.
